LHAUG meetings and seminars are video-recorded, and the recording is posted on the publicly-accessible club website, www.lhaug.org.

By attending a meeting or seminar, you consent to having your name, video, and audio included in this recording and posted on the website.

If you are attending via Zoom and do not wish to appear in the recording, you may keep your video turned off and mute your audio. However, your displayed name might still appear in the recording.

Recording of LHAUG meetings and seminars by anyone other than the host is prohibited.

Zoom attendees should follow these guidelines:

- Use the latest version of Zoom software because security vulnerabilities are more likely to be exploited on older software versions.
- Ensure that the area behind you is free of anything you do not want included in the recording. Depending on your device, you can use an appropriate virtual background or a blurred or grey background.
- Be mindful of others in your location who might not wish to be visible or recorded in the background.
- To prevent background noise from disrupting the presentation, remain muted until the Q & A time after the presentation.
