
















Checklist: "25 Ways Your iPhone Can Make Travel Easier"		
	Apps	Built-in Features
<input type="checkbox"/>		Use the Tips app on iPhone. Go to the Tips app on your iPhone. Scroll to the bottom of the Tips app, then tap the user guide you want to browse.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spotlight Search or Ask Siri	Search for apps: Swipe down in the middle of the screen to quickly search for apps, or tap the Search icon on the Home Screen and type the app name. Alternatively, ask Siri, "Hey Siri, open," and then say the app name.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Find My: Set up on your iPhone to locate items using Air Tags, view a list of all your devices, and pinpoint the location of friends and family. For more detailed instructions, refer to the iPhone User Guide.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Apple Pay: Set up for travel. Organize travel essentials like boarding passes, tickets, and payment methods in the Wallet app. To add items, open the app, tap "+," choose what you want to add, and follow the on-screen instructions. To pay with Apple Pay, double-click the side button (or Home button on older iPhones), authenticate, and hold your iPhone near the contactless reader until "Done" or a checkmark appears. For help, refer to the iPhone User Guide.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Clock: Add places you're visiting and your home time to the app. Tap "World Clock" at the bottom. Add a city by tapping "+" and choosing one from the list.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Weather: Stay updated on weather conditions to plan your day and pack accordingly. Add places you're visiting and check the weather back home. Set location access to "Always" or "While Using the App". To add locations, tap the Search for a city, neighborhood, or location, and tap "Add". Swipe up to view weather details, including hourly and daily forecasts. Swipe left or right to view the hourly forecast. Tap the map icon to see a weather map.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spotlight Search	Spotlight Search: For currency conversions, type \$ amount, Or, press and hold \$ key on keyboard for different conversion symbols.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Calculator: Use the app to quickly convert between currencies. Go to the Calculator app on your iPhone. Tap the icon in lower left corner, then turn on Convert. Choose the currency you want.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Notes: Before you go, note travel plans and itineraries. You can share your notes also. Store pictures of passports and confirmation information. During travels, keep journal notes about places you visit for future reference.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Reminders: Create lists and templates for packing lists, reservation and final payment due dates.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Calendar: Keep track of your travel schedule, appointments, and events. Create a shared calendar with flights and events, invite fellow travelers to events or share your calendar. Set events with time zone for tour or theater tickets.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Spotlight Search	To track your flight, bring up spotlight search. Type in air flight code. View the flight status. For more details, tap the flight number in the search field.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Messages: One more way to track your flight. Flight code sent or received in Messages shows up as a link. Tap the link for more flight information.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Download airline apps in advance. Boarding Passes originate there. You can get updates, information, locate bags. Often allow you to add your boarding pass to your Wallet.

	Apps	Built-in Features
<input type="checkbox"/>		Keep Files Downloaded: To ensure files downloaded on your iPhone remain accessible, even when offline, use the "Keep Downloaded" option within the Files app after long-pressing the file and selecting "Keep Downloaded."
<input type="checkbox"/>		Books: Download digital travel guidebooks for that location from the Apple Books store. Weightless, searchable, can mark with highlights and bookmark favorite places to visit. Always with you.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Translate: Tap Translate mode to type or speak text and it will translate it.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Translate: Tap Conversation mode to talk back and forth as a translator.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Translate: Tap Camera mode to translate things like signs or menus, and then take a picture to save menus or directions.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Photos: After you've taken a picture use the photo app to identify what you are seeing, get information about landmarks.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Maps: It gives you all the info you need, like directions, 3D flyovers, and even offline maps. Download them over WiFi to save on data and stay connected even without an internet connection. Save your favorite spots to the Library for easy access, pin them, and add notes. You can even share your estimated time of arrival (ETA) with friends or family right from the app.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Compass: Useful on a hike and you don't have Maps available. Quick way to see longitude, latitude and altitude.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Message: open a conversation, tap the "+" icon, select "Location," and then tap "Send".
<input type="checkbox"/>		App Store: Search for where you're going. You may find some local apps, sometimes for free, that give you information about the place you're traveling to. Do a web search for what ride sharing apps work in the location you're going to. You might need different service.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Journal: Use for a personalized travel journal to capture thoughts, photos, videos, and even audio, and geotag entries. Entries can help you remember and reflect on your experiences. You can lock your journal so only you can access it.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Voice Memos: An alternative to recording experiences. On latest iPhones it will transcribe what you say so you do have some text when you are done.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Apple Music: Listen to local music while you're there or maybe get ready for the trip by listening before you go. Search for a place and find playlists and even streaming radio stations for that location. For example, you can listen to 'Top 100' lists from around the world.
<input type="checkbox"/>		Photos: Share your best photos while you're traveling with the other travelers and people back home. Can control everything rather than putting them on a social media network. In the Photos app go to Albums, choose Shared, then tap Create. Enter name for the album. To invite people, tap Invite. Enter the name of a contact you want to add, or type the email address or phone number associated with the recipient's Apple Account.
