

Interesting Tips (iOS 15) For Your iPhone

(Note: The “Show Reader” (AA) View Option isn’t available on All Websites and Articles. When you Tap on (AA) and the list has “Show Reader” in Gray, then “Show Reader” View isn’t available on this website or article. [See I, II, & III below])

I. How To Print Safari Web Pages Without Ads ...

1. Start on the Article or Webpage That You Want to Print ...

- **Tap** on the **(AA) Icon** to the **Left** of Your **Browser Address Bar ...**
- **Tap** on the **Show Reader** View ...
- The **(AA) Icon** Should Now be **Black**, and the **Article/Webpage** should be **Cleaner ...**
- Then, **Tap** the **Share Icon** at the **Bottom** of the **Screen ...**
- **Scroll Down** and **Tap Print**, **Select** Your **(Air) Printer** and **Tap Print** again.

II. How To Save A Web Page As A PDF On An iPhone ...

1. Open Safari And Go To The Web Page You Want To Save ...

- **Tap** on the **(AA) Icon** to the **Left** of Your **Browser Address Bar ...**
- **Select Show Reader** View, **Tap** the **Share Icon** at the **Bottom** of the **Screen ...**
- **Scroll** through the **Share Options** and **Select** the **Books Icon**
- Once you **Select** the **Books App**, the file will be prepared, and the **Books App** will **Open** and **Save** your new **PDF**.

III. How to Take an iPhone Scrolling Screenshot ...

1. **Open** the **Web Page** in **Safari** that you'd like to **Capture** and **Take A Screenshot** as you normally would.

- **Tap** the **Screenshot Preview**, that **Pops Up** in the **Lower-left Corner** of your screen ...
- **Tap** “**Full Page**” **Tab** at the **Top** of your **Screen ...**
- **Tap Done ...**
- You’ll be **Given** the **Options** to **Save PDF to Files**, **Delete Screenshot**, or **Cancel ...**
- **Tap Save PDF to Files** to **Save** your **PDF Scrolling Screenshot ...**
- **Choose** Where to **Save** your **PDF Scrolling Screenshot** And **Tap Save**.

IV. How To Scan A QR Code With The Camera ...

1. Open the Settings App ...

- **Tap** the **Camera Icon ...**
- **Scroll** to the **Scan QR Codes** Option and **Tap It On (Highlight Button)**.
- **Open** the **Camera App ...**
- **Hold** the **Camera Over** the **QR Code** and **Center** It in the **Frame ...**
- A **Notification** will **Appear** and **Display What** the **AR Code Opens ...**
- **Tap On** the **Notification** to **Open** the **QR Destination Link** or ...
- **Tap On** the **Notification** to **Open** the **Phone Number**.

V. How to Write Notes from Your iPhone Lock Screen ...

1. Open the Settings App ...

- **Tap** on Control Center Icon ...
- **Scroll Down** and **Tap** on Notes, a Green (+) Button.

2. Open the Settings App ...

- **Tap On** the Face ID & Passcode or Touch ID & Passcode (*Based on iPhone Model*) then Enter Your iPhone's Passcode ...
- **Scroll Down** will **Turn On** the **Control Center** Button ...
- **Test It ...** Put Your iPhone To Sleep, **Press the Side Button to Wake It Up, Swipe Down From the Upper Right Corner (or Bottom Up Half-Way)** to Get the Control Panel ... **Tap On** Notes Icon and **Write** a Note!

VI. How to Decline Call on iPhone in 3 Ways ...

1. If the Call Comes in **While you are Using** the iPhone, then **Tap Decline/Hang Up Button**.
2. If the Call Comes when the iPhone is **Locked or Asleep**, **Press the Side Button Twice** (*Since the Decline Option Won't Be On the Screen*).
3. If You're **Using AirPods Pro**, **Double Press** the Force Sensor on the Stem of your AirPods Pro to **Decline** the Call, and **Send It to Voicemail**. If you're **Using First-generation AirPods**, you can **Tap the Side of Either AirPods Twice**, which will **Answer the Call**. **Tapping It Twice Again** will End It.

VII. How to Delete Digits in iPhone Calculator ...

1. On Home Screen, **Swipe (Right Top Down or Bottom Up Half-Way)** For Control Center ...
 - **Tap** on Calculator Icon ...
 - **Tap Numbers 123446**, Then **Swipe Over** the Numbers (*From Right to Left Or Left to Right*) Two Times, And then **Tap** the 5 and 6 ...
 - Now you have the **Correct Number ... 123456**.

VIII. How Forward a Text Message on an iPhone ...

1. Open Messages, Open a Conversation with the Text to Forward ...

- **Long Press** on the **Body** of the **Message** and **Tap "More"**...
- All the **Messages** will have small circles to the **Left** of each Text. **Tap** the **Circle Next** to any other **Messages** you also want to **Forward** ...
- **Tap On** the **Forward Icon** and a **New Message** will **Open** ...
- **Enter** your **Recipient's Contact Information** ...
- **Tap On Send**. (*Much better than Retyping the Message.*)

IX. How to Take a Still Photo While Shooting Video ...

1. Open the Camera App ...

- **Swipe Over** to **Video** (or **Tap Video** in the **Mode Menu**) ...
- **Tap** the **Red Shutter Button** in the **Bottom Center** to **Start Recording Video ...**
- To **Take a Still Photo** while you're **Recording**, **Tap** the **White Shutter Button Located** in the **Bottom Right Corner** of the **Screen**. The photo will **Automatically Save** to your **Photos App**.

X. How to Take a Selfie with Siri ...

1. **Say, "Hey Siri" to activate Siri.** *(Or hold the Home button or Side button) ...*

- **Say, "Hey Siri, Take a Selfie Photo."** *(If you only say, "Hey Siri, take a Selfie", Siri will start reading you the definition of a selfie from the web)...*
- **Siri will Open the Camera App** on your iPhone in **Photo Mode** on your **Front-Facing camera**.
- Now **Tap** the **Shutter Button** to **Take** your **Selfie**. *(You can also use the Volume up or down buttons on the side of your iPhone.)*
