

iPhone: Interesting and Fun Stuff in iOS 17

How Do You Resend an Email? ...

- 1. On your iPhone, Open the “Mail” app ...**
 - **Go** to “Mailboxes” ...
 - **Tap On** “Sent” ...
 - **Tap On** the “eMail” to **Resend** ...
 - **Tap** the “**Reply Arrow**” of the eMail to **Resend** ...
 - **Scroll** and **Tap** the “**Send Again**” Option ...
 - Now, you can **Edit** the “**Body**” of the email, **Change** the “**Recipients**”, and **Send** the eMail Again!

Easily Blur a Photo’s Background on iPhone 15 ...

- 1. Open Photos (iOS 17) ...**
 - **Select** a “**Live Photo**” in the “**Photos**” app, (You’ll see a “**Live**” icon or “**Portrait**” with an “**F-stop symbol**” next to it.) ...
 - **Tap** the “**Live/Portrait Icon**” in the **Upper Left Corner**...
 - **Tap Portrait** to **Add** a “**Blurred Background**” to the photo ...
 - If you want to **Change** the “**Focus**” of the photo, **Tap** “**Edit**” ...
 - **Tap** the “**Portrait Icon**” if it is not already selected, and **Drag** the “**Slider Left and Right**” to **Change** the “**Focus**” of the “**Photo**”.

How To Save a Webpage as a PDF on Safari ...

- 1. On your iPhone or iPad, Open “Safari” ...**
 - **Open** the “**Webpage**” you want to **Save** as a PDF and **Tap** the “**Share Button**” ...
 - **Tap** “**Options**”, then **Tap** “**PDF**” ...
 - **Scroll Down** to “**Save to Files**” ...
 - **And Tap** “**Save to Files**” ...
 - **Choose** a “**Location on your iCloud Account**” to **Save** the “**PDF**” ...
 - Then **Tap** “**Save**”.

How To Print Safari Web Pages Without Ads ...

- 1. Start on the Article or Webpage That You Want to Print ...**
 - **Tap** on the **AA Icon** to the **Left** of Your **Browser Bar** ...
 - **Tap** on the **Show Reader View** ...
 - The **AA Icon** Should Now be **Black**, and the **Article/Webpage** should be **Cleaner** ...
 - Then, **Tap** the **Share Icon** at the **Bottom** of the **Screen** ...
 - **Scroll Down** and **Tap Print**, **Select** Your (**Air**) **Printer** and **Tap Print** again.

Save a Web Page as a PDF In Books App ...

1. **Open Safari And Go To The Web Page You Want To Save ...**
 - **Tap** on the **AA Icon** to the **Left** of Your **Browser Address Bar ...**
 - **Select Show Reader View, Tap** the **Share Icon** at the **Bottom** of the **Screen ...**
 - **Scroll** through the **Share Options** and **Select** the **Books Icon**
 - Once you **Select** the **Books App**, the file will be prepared, and the **Books App** will **Open** and **Save** your new PDF.

How to Mass Delete Text Messages on iPhone ...

1. **Open** any **Text Conversation** in the **Messages App ...**
 - **Long Press** on Any Message, then **Tap More ...**
 - Circles Slide In from the Left Edge of the Screen for Each Message ...
 - Then, **Tap** a **Circle**, and it'll **Turn Blue** with a **Checkmark** in the **Middle ...**
 - **Check Off** as many **Messages** as you want ...
 - **Tap** the **Trash Can Icon** in the **Lower Left ...**
 - **Tap Delete Message.**
 - *(Note: Quickly clear up your messages by getting rid of messages you don't need anymore. You can delete individual messages without deleting the whole conversation.)*

How to Easily Track Flights on iPhone ...

1. **Go To** any **iMessage Conversation** with a **Flight Number** in it ...
 - **Tap** a **Flight Number** that has been **Sent** to you ...
 - If **Someone** has **Not Sent** you their **Flight Number**, you can **Type It** in a message to Yourself and **Hit Send ...**
 - **Tap** the **Airline/Flight Number ...**
 - **Tap Preview Flight ...**
 - You'll **See All** the **Flight Details ...**
 - **Tap Done** to **Dismiss** the **iMessage Flight Tracker.**

Add: Check Apple Watch Battery on Your iPhone ...

1. **Swipe Right** on your **Home / Lock Screen** for the **Today View ...**
 - **Scroll Down** to the **Bottom** and **Tap Edit ...**
 - **Tap** the **Add Icon (Top Left) ...**
 - **Scroll Down** until you **See** "**Batteries**" and **Tap It ...**
 - **Swipe Horizontally** to **See** the "**Different Options**" ...
 - Once you **See** the **Size** you **Want**, **Tap Add Widget ...**
 - You can **Drag** the **Batteries Widget** to **Reposition It Based** on your **Preference.**

How To Take a Screenshot on Your iPhone ...

1. Get to the iPhone Screen you Want to Capture ...

- **Simultaneously Press** the **Sleep/Wake Button** on the **Right-Hand Side**, and the **Volume Up Button** on the **Left Side**, and **Quickly Release Both Buttons ...**
- When you **See** the **Screen Flash White** (*and possibly Hear the Camera Shutter*), the **Screenshot** has been **Captured** and **Appears** in the **Lower Left Section** of your **iPhone** for **about 5 seconds ...**
- If you **Immediately Tap** on the **Thumbnail Image**, the **Captured Image** **Appears** on **Another Screen** where you can **Resize**, **Add Comments**, **Send it Somewhere**, **Etc. ...**
- When you are **Finished**, **Tap Done** and **Select** your **Option** from the **Pop-Up List ...**
- If you **Don't Tap** the **Lower Left-Hand Thumbnail Image** **Immediately**, then the **Photo** is **Added Directly** to the **Photos App**.

Create a Slideshow in Photos on Your iPhone...

1. Open the Photos App on your iPhone ...

- **Tap** the **Albums Tab** on the **Bottom** of the **Screen ...**
- **Select** the **Album** you **Want to Turn Into** a **Slideshow ...**
- **Tap** the **Three Dots (...)** on the **Top Right ...**
- **Scroll Down** the **List** and **Tap** on **Slideshow ...**
- (*The Slideshow will automatically begin to Play with Music and Transitions Added. To Pause the Slideshow, Tap the Screen to Bring Up the Menu ...*)
- **Tap** the **Play/Pause Button** to **Pause ...**
- To **Edit** the **Slideshow**, **Tap Options ...**
- From **Options**, you can **Choose** the **Layout**, **Music**, **Repeat**, and **Speed** of the **Slideshow** (*When Finished with Edit, Tap Done to Return to Slideshow ...*)
- **Tap** the **AirPlay Icon** in the **Top Right** to **Share** your **Slideshow** to another screen, like your **TV** or **MacBook ...**
- **Tap Done** (*in the upper Left Corner of the screen*) to **End** the **Slideshow**.
